

Care of Course

1. Replace all divots. Ensure that any turf cut or displaced is returned at once and pressed down carefully.
2. Repair all damages to the putting greens made by ball marks or spikes before leaving the green (fix yours and one other).
3. Rake and smooth down sand in all bunkers. When you're finished, leave the rake in the bunker, teeth down.
4. Place all trash in the trash receptacles provided.
5. Golf bags will not be placed on the greens.
6. Pull carts will remain at least 10 feet away from all greens and off all trees.

Driving Range

1. Players will hit balls toward markers.
2. Balls will not be taken off the driving range.
3. Use of range balls for play is strictly prohibited.
4. Return ball buckets to the ball machine.
5. Use of unauthorized tokens in the ball machines will result in suspension of golf course privileges and possible civil action.

Special Play

1. Wednesday is Ladies Day, unless it is a holiday. Ladies will have priority use of the course from 8:30 to 9:30am.
2. Tuesday and Wednesday (April through August): Travis AFB intramural golf teams have priority use of the course from noon to 1pm.
3. Twilight golf rate: April through September in effect after 3pm; November through February in effect after 1pm;
October & March in effect after 2pm

Children

1. Children under 8 years old will not be allowed on the course under any circumstances.
2. Children 8 to 15 years old must be accompanied by an adult member unless approved for individual play by the manager.
3. Unaccompanied children under 12 years old will not be allowed to play unless enrolled in the Junior Golf Program.

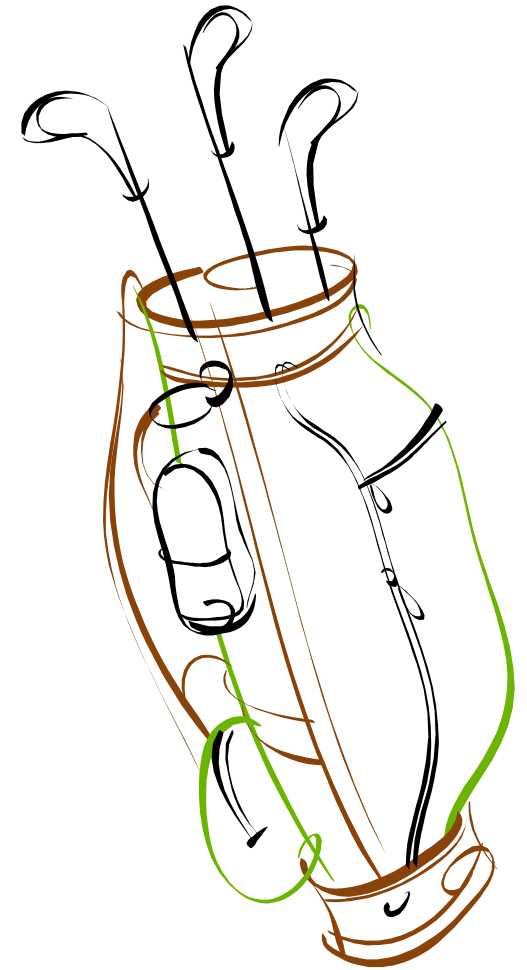

RULES AND POLICIES

General Rules

1. Cypress Lakes Golf Course is for the use of active and retired military personnel and their families, reserve components, and DoD civilians and their families. Guests are invited/welcomed to play.

2. Yearly or daily fees must be paid prior to play on the course. People playing the course must have in their possession a receipt for the day indicating they have paid the appropriate fees and registered at the Pro Shop.

3. Suitable attire will be worn at all times. The wearing of military uniforms, or parts of military uniforms, while playing golf is strictly prohibited. Shirts, designed for outer wear, must be worn at all times. The following attire is not authorized: bathing suits, gym shorts, jogging shorts, sweat-pants, spandex pants or any type of form-fitting material, cutoffs (shirt or shorts), men's tank tops or muscle shirts, see-thru garments or any garment that exposes the bare midriff areas.

4. Only golf shoes, flat soled sneakers or tennis shoes will be permitted on the course. Metal spikes are not allowed.

5. Powered rental carts are limited to two riders. Individuals renting carts must be at least 16 years of age, and have a valid driver's license. Carts will not be driven closer than 30 feet from tees and greens, except on cart paths, or designated handicap flag has been authorized.

Rules of Play



6. Play on Saturday, Sunday and holidays will be confined to groups of three or four unless, in the opinion of the manager on duty, play on the course dictates otherwise.



7. Players making the turn after completing nine holes must go on to the next tee before the following group is ready to tee off or lose their position. Groups losing their position must wait for a break in play before continuing.

6. Use the 90-degree rule for power carts unless otherwise posted.

7. Golf clubs may be rented on a daily basis. All players must have a set of clubs, unless otherwise authorized by management.

8. Locker rental is available on a yearly basis.

9. All rental equipment must be returned 30 minutes prior to closing.

10. Food and beverages must be purchased at the Cypress Lakes Golf Course. No private coolers are allowed on the course.

11. Tee times: Reservations will be accepted from active duty military personnel stationed at Travis AFB seven (7) days in advance. All other eligible patrons may call five (5) days in advance. Tee times can be reserved in person, by calling (707) 448-7186.

12. Handicap: Male and female golfers desiring a handicap record may join the Northern California Golf Association.

13. If the course is closed for inclement weather or active duty personnel are recalled, a rain check may be issued by the manager or designated representative.

14. All players are required to register in the Pro Shop prior to play.

15. Play will start on the first hole unless permission is granted by the manager or designated representative to do otherwise.

16. Retrieving golf balls from the lakes is not permitted, except by players attempting to find their own ball.

17. The Cypress Lakes Golf Course pro/manager or designated representative has the authority to request anyone to leave the premises for misconduct or cause.
