What you can expect from OAP

We will inform you of risks and anticipated curriculum, but it must be understood that any activity comes with hazards and dangers that are not always anticipated. It should also be understood that unanticipated situations do occur and expectations are not always met. We try to do everything in our power to make this a great, meaningful experience for you.

What we expect of you
In order to maintain high safety standards, all participants are to comply with Outdoor Recreation's policies and procedures explained by our leaders.

A clear head is important to ensure actions are essential for safety and the success of each trip. Drugs and alcohol on any outing are against Outdoor Recreation Policy.

You are a full member of a team meaning that we depend on each other for safety. In case of an any order to the process we may request and expect your assistance.

emergency; and because we work in remote areas we may request and expect your assistance. Participants should respect the fragile wilderness areas we use.

Violation of these principles may result in expulsion. If you are asked to leave a trip because of misconduct, you will forfeit trip fees and receive a charge for evacuation from the backcountry.

PRE-TRIP MEETINGS

Pre-trip meetings are mandatory for all participants on selected OAP outings. Pre-trip meetings are scheduled up to one week before the trip depending upon the trip you sign-up for. We gather for pre-trip meetings to meet other participants and to get all the information necessary for your trip. You will be unable to participate in the outing if you do not attend this meeting. Attendance is to ensure you are well prepared for the outing.

SIGN-UP INFORMATION

To sign up for any of Outdoor Recreation's trips or tours just come into Outdoor Recreation. Sign ups are taken up to two days prior to the departure of the trip. We will only accept late registration on a case-bycase basis. Sign ups for our trips are on a first-come first-serve basis and must be paid in full to reserve your spot. Some trips fill up quickly so please plan accordingly. When trips do not meet the minimum participation, trips will be cancelled, please sign up well in advance. Most Outdoor Adventure Program outings and ITT trips are for ages 6+ and some have age requirements; please check before registering.

REFUND POLICY

If the outing is cancelled by Outdoor Recreation a refund will be offered to all who are signed up. If you are unable to attend the outing as planned and would like a refund, you must cancel 48 hours prior to the "sign up by" date. Cancelling any later than this time will result in forfeiture of your trip fees, however, there is a chance that you can sell your spot to someone else. If a refund is rewarded, you have 30 days



ALAMERE FALLS HIKE



March 1 | 8:00am - 5:00pm Cost: 25 | Ages: 18+

Point Reyes National Sea Shore is a remarkably beautiful location with spectacular views. We will be hiking 4 miles in to Alemere Falls, which cascade (weather dependent) onto the beach before flowing into the Pacific Ocean. This hike is a spectacular sight for anyone, and a great way to enjoy the serenity of the Pacific Ocean. This is a fairly flat trail with minimal elevation gain, but plan to spend a few hours walking and scrambling as we travel 8 miles round trip. The falls are seasonal and weather dependant, so cross your fingers for some wet weather! No matter what, bring your cameras as we will be heading ultimately to the beach and back.

The Pine Ridge Trail is located in Big Sur wilderness just a few short hours from Travis. This out and back trail will take us up 10 miles to the Sykes Hot Spring Campground. We will camp 8 miles in the first night, making the final 2 mile push to Sykes Hot Springs the next day where we will spend the day soaking those sore muscles in this year round 100+ degree natural hot tub! Don't forget to get a good night's rest as it will be a full 10 mile hike out on Sunday.

This is a strenuous hike. Participants should be skilled and confident hiker. All meals, transportation and guides provided. Backpacks, sleeping bags and tents may be available, ask upon registration. This is THE Overnight Backpacking Trip in the San Francisco area, don't miss out!

This 5 weekend training will cover skills and safety, river hydrology, river flows, scouting rapdis, running rapids, guides strokes, river and patron ettiquette, camp and kitchen operations, knots, raft rigging, swift water rescue skills and much more! Don'f forget your sleeping bags and tents, we will be camping out riverside on the South Fork of the American River each weekend. This training is open to men and women of all ranks; Active Duty, Reservists, Dependants, Retiree's and DoD Employeess. We provide all water equipment, transportation, instruction and food! SWIFTWATER RESCUE

The Swiftwater Rescue workshop teaches recognition and avoidance of common river hazards, execution of self-rescue techniques and rescue techniques for paddlers in distress. Emphasis is placed both on personal safety and on simple, commonly used skills. Techniques for dealing with hazards that carry greater risks for both victim and rescuer, such as strainers, rescue vest applications, entrapments and pins, are also practiced. Scenarios will provide an opportunity for participants to practice their skills both individually and within a team/group context.

This course is mandatory to complete Raft Guide Training.


