

Travis Resale Lot Information

60th Force Support Squadron is not responsible for damages or stolen vehicles.

Use of the Vehicle or RV Resale Lots is at owner's risk!

By signing the Travis AFB Arts & Crafts User Agreement Form customer acknowledges having read the information regarding use of the Travis Resale Lot.

Privately Owned Vehicle Lot

- Resale lot customers are limited to no more than three vehicle sales per year. This rule is due to continued abuse by patrons utilizing the resale lots as a business venture.
- The permit fee is \$15.00 for 15 calendar days. This fee is non-refundable.
- Also, due at time of registration is a \$10.00 deposit. This deposit is refundable. You must bring your original receipt to the Auto Shop within seven days (Monday-Saturday) from your "due out" date to receive a refund.
- If you exceed seven days, the refund is **forfeited**.
- You will be assigned a numbered space on the lot. Numbers are painted on the pavement at the lot. You can find the number in the "assigned area" box on your receipt and also on the "for sale" permit.
- If your vehicle does not sale and you wish to renew your permit, you must return to the Auto Shop on or before the "due out" date on the receipt/permit.
- When returning for a refund or to renew your permit, you must first visit the Auto Shop counter. The cashier will issue your permit and take payment.
- The most current permit must be displayed at all times on the vehicle being sold.
- There is a three month limit to display a vehicle. Once three months have been reached, the owner cannot display the same vehicle for a period of three months thereafter; for a total of six months annually.
- *****Note***** When returning for a renewal or refund, please bring your original agreement form receipt (yellow). This will help facilitate a quicker transaction. Please visit the Auto Shop prior to seeing the cashier.
- Sellers of motorcycles, motor scooters and mopeds will not permit untrained potential military buyers to test drive the vehicle. Potential military buyers must provide proof of training (e.g. Motorcycle Safety Foundation Card, or ation safety staff stipulating individual's licensing state has been approved by the Motorcycle Safety Foundation) before test driving the vehicle.

Recreational Vehicle (RV) Lot

- A license number is required to obtain a permit.
- The permit fee is \$22.50 for 15 calendar days. This fee is non-refundable.
- Also, due at time of registration is a \$25.00 deposit. This deposit is refundable. You must bring your original receipt to the Auto Shop within seven days (Monday-Saturday) from your “due out” date to receive a refund.
- If you exceed seven days, the refund is **forfeited**.
- The RV lot is not numbered and you can select the best location to display your vehicle.
- There is a three month limit to display a RV. Once three months have been reached, the owner cannot display the same RV for a period of three months thereafter; for a total of six months annually.
- The above **Resale Lot** information also pertains to all recreational vehicles.
